“MOTTA (Take out Help Checkup Terminal)”

- **What is equally important compared to safety of the family when an earthquake happens, is to instantly decide what to bring with you when evacuating.**
- **However, even if you were to prepare for this, can you actually move precisely while in a rush?**
- **Jewelry, seals, accessories, emergency bags etc...**

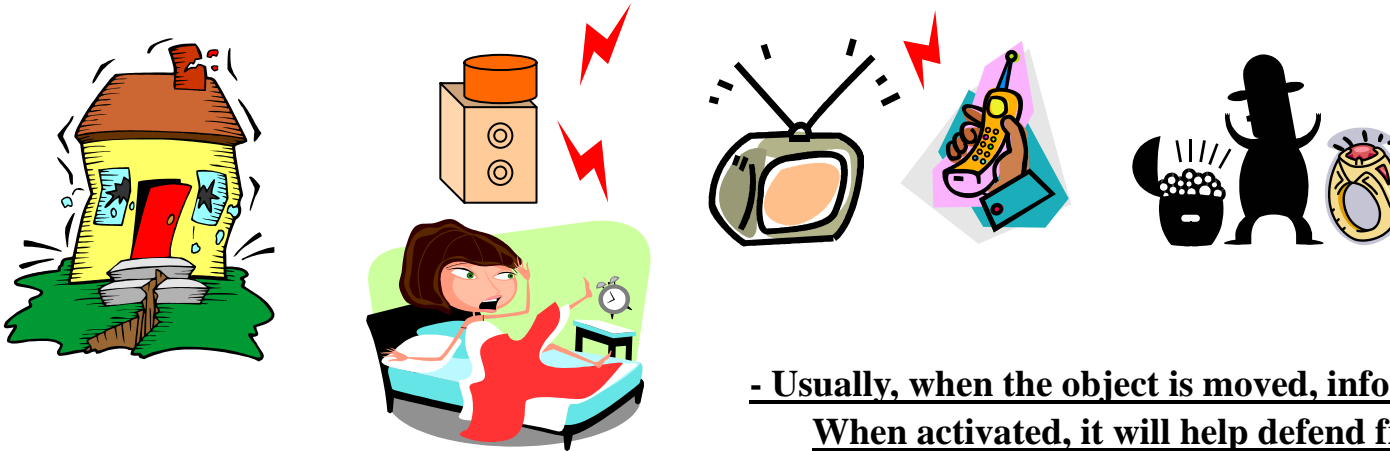
All goods planned to take out will probably not be in the same place.

Where did I put it? Where did I hide it?

This is where I propose the "Emergency Takeout Control System" using IPv6.

The home sensor placed at a specific position detects the earthquake. Then...

- Information such as “where the object is” is
 - Displayed on TV with a flashing and blueprint of the house
 - E-mail such as “second drawer in bedroom” is sent to the cellular phone of the entire family At the same time, alarm and lighting will turn on to appeal the existence of the case.
- Little bit of ease will help to move quickly.



- Usually, when the object is moved, information is sent to the family.
When activated, it will help defend from thieves.
